- 4th Anniversary of YCVP sponsoring day of service
- 1st year a project will take place in the Verde Valley!



YCVP and MLK Jr. Day of Service

- In 2010 engaged over 400 individuals and 2,030 hours of service
- 2011 4th year YCVP has sponsored
- 2011 Goals:
 - Minimum of 5 project sites
 - Expand to Verde Valley
 - Minimum of 300 Volunteers
 - Minimum of 20 Partners



What Type of Service is Encouraged?

- All types! But especially...
 - Opportunities to connect year-round
 - Lasting impact
 - Help bring about community solutions
 - Ultimately reflect life and teachings of Dr. King.



Service for Peace



- “Connecting people to peace through service.”
- Award organizations up to \$10,000 to support MLK Jr. event
- Pledge of Peace/Nonviolence
- YCVP awarded \$2,500 for 2011 Event
- \$60 to each project site for supplies



Beaver Creek as a Key Partner/Signature Site

- At least 1 project – site responsible for liability insurance
- 40-60 participants
- Variety of ages, skills sets
- Centralized kick-off in morning
- 6-7 hours engaged in service

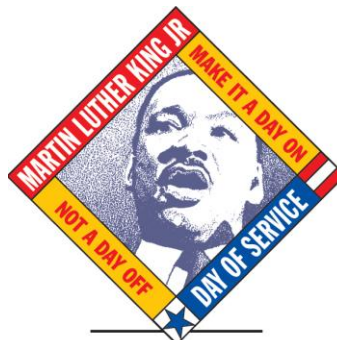
