The application to United Way was submitted under Beaver Creek Regional Council & Beaver Creek School District for the BCRC portion of the worker. If approved, the above pledges would be returned to the donors.

The application for the Vista Worker was a 3 year award and initially submitted by the Beaver Creek School District. The project was expanded to BCRC for the 2nd year go around which is how the worker was phased into the Youth and Family Committee of BCRC.

The school provided the match for the first 2 years and is now asking BCRC to pick up 50% of the match for the 3rd year worker. In exchange for BCRC and/or the community picking up 50% of the match, the Vista worker will work on other community projects in addition to current youth and family programs (food distribution – which is now established and will require less time). For example, at least 50% or more of their time will be spent on transportation, open space, land use and water issues.

The worker will also work on recruiting, training of fresh blood volunteer, communication networks and resource development (grant writing). It's possible they can also help with the BCRC & LMPOA websites and newsletters.
